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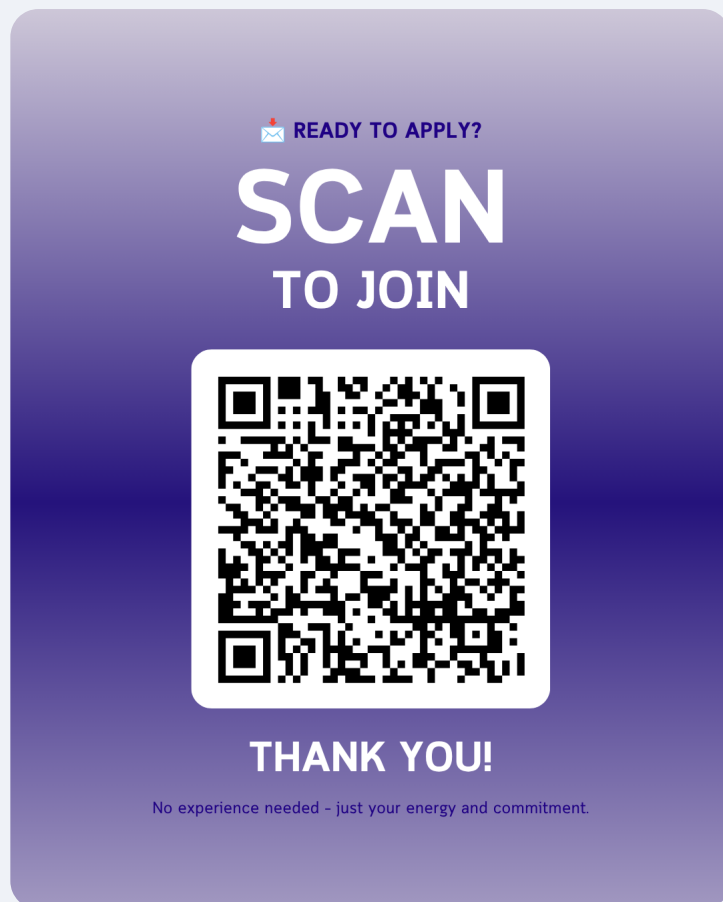

LIVE-Ex, the Living Earth Virtual Exchange, is open again for its fourth cohort. It's a free online programme for young people and youth workers who want to work on climate and environmental justice, with a focus on Sub-Saharan Africa.

Over around six online sessions, participants discuss climate and environmental justice, design small local actions, and pick up practical tools for advocacy and fundraising, all while connecting with people from different countries. Everyone is paired with a mentor from a partner organisation and builds their own local action project step by step using the LIVE-Ex toolkit. At the end of the cohort, participant projects can win €200 in prizes.

No previous experience is needed. Just curiosity, a commitment to attend the dialogues, and an internet connection.
